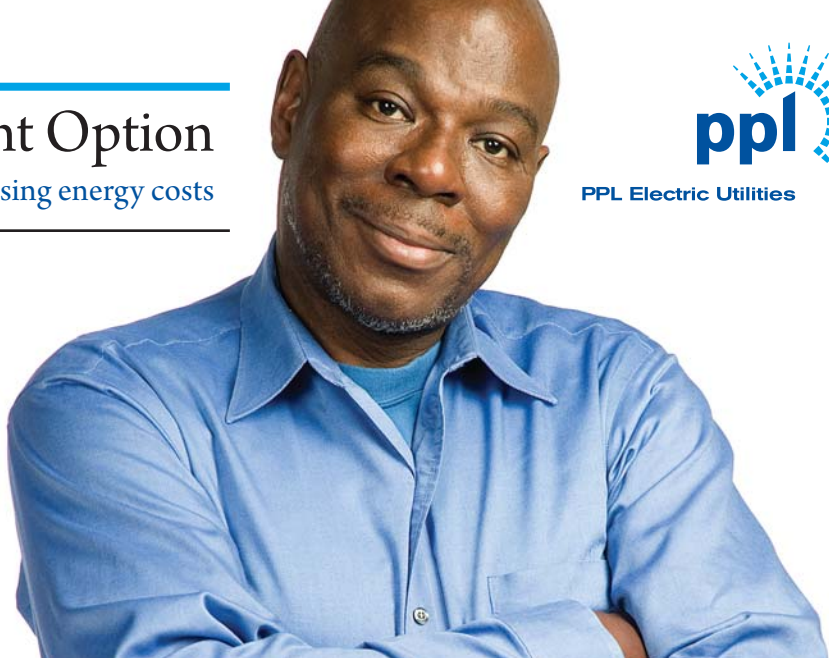
# Phase-in Payment Option

The easy way to smooth out rising energy costs

PPL Electric Utilities' **phase-in payment option** can help you adjust to higher electricity costs in 2010 gradually, rather than all at once. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission has approved this phase-in option. It's a voluntary program. **You** decide if you wish to participate.

Prices will increase when a rate cap on the generation charge portion of your electric bill ends December 31, 2009. Since the cap was put in place in 1999, the cost to generate electricity has increased significantly. While we won't know exactly how much bills will increase until closer to 2010, we estimate, based on the cost of electricity we've purchased already for 2010, that total monthly bills could increase by 30 percent or more.

To enroll in the phase-in option:

Since the program started this month, you will need to make a one-time, catch-up payment equal to the months you've missed.
