

Three things to know about Electric Choice



1. The power to choose is yours.

Pennsylvania's Electric Choice program lets you choose the company that generates your electricity. Whether or not you choose a new electric generation supplier, PPL Electric Utilities will continue to deliver safe, reliable electric service to your home or business.

Now that rate caps have expired, you have greater opportunities to shop for generation supply.

2. Your Price to Compare is your key to shopping.

You can use the Price to Compare to evaluate prices offered by competitive electric generation suppliers. If a supplier's price is lower than your Price to Compare, you can save money by choosing that supplier. We are providing you this information because the Price to Compare does not appear on your electric bill.

The Price to Compare includes generation and transmission charges only. Other charges that appear on your bill, such as distribution charges, are still paid to PPL Electric Utilities.

3. Information is available to help you compare supplier offers.

The chart on the back page shows the average Price to Compare for customers in various rate groups. Your rate group can be found on your monthly bill. Your Price to Compare will vary monthly depending on your electricity use, which you can find on the summary page of your electric bill, next to the electric usage chart.

Note to customers on closed residential rate schedules

PPL Electric Utilities has other residential rate schedules that were closed several years ago but remain in effect for homes that were on those rates at the time they were closed. If you are on Rate Schedule RTS, your Price to Compare for 2010 is 9.098 cents. If you are on Rate Schedule RTD or the RW1 service option under Rate Schedule RS, your Price to Compare for 2010 is 10.448 cents.

Note to small-, mid-sized business customers

PPL Electric Utilities offers regulated services, including Provider of Last Resort (POLR) service, under rate schedules approved by the PUC. Small- and mid-sized business customers who return to PPL Electric Utilities for electricity supply in 2010 after being served by an alternative supplier must remain with POLR service through the end of 2010.

If a small- or mid-sized business customer shops again for an alternative supplier before the end of 2010, it must pay an additional charge based on market prices in effect while it was receiving POLR services. For information about this provision, call 1-888-220-9991.
