Third Party Supplement Addendum

Will you own and operate your renewable energy installation? If you have not yet decided, refer to our Third Party FAQs. If you decide upon a Third Party installation, you <u>must</u> complete <u>this</u> Third Party Supplement Addendum.

In accordance with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PaPUC) Final Order on March 29, 2012, customer-generators may contract with Third-parties to perform the operational functions of the alternative energy system. Under this arrangement, the system is only eligible for net metering if it is designed to generate no more than 110% of the customer-generator's historic annual electric consumption. This consumption is the customer-generator's total electric usage in the twelve full months immediately preceding the customer-generator's submission of the interconnection application. Note that the PaPUC categorized the 110% consumption limit as a "design parameter" that must be complied with during the design phase. A system that is owned *and* operated by a customer-generator itself, and not a third-party, is not subject to the 110% consumption limit at this time.

Other conditions may apply to your installation.

- Electric services with less than one year of consumption data The PaPUC requires that when a customer-generator and developer seek to develop an alternative energy system in connection with a new building, the customer-generator and/or developer must provide an estimate of annual electric consumption for the new building and demonstrate that the system design does not exceed 110% of the annual estimated consumption. The customer-generator and/or developer must provide adequate support for the estimated consumption with the interconnection application, which may include one or more years of historical usage or estimates based on similarly equipped and utilized buildings.
- The PaPUC noted that the 110% consumption limitation also applies to interconnection applications seeking to expand an existing alternative energy system.
- Finally, the PaPUC clarifies that, with respect to virtual meter aggregation, the 110% consumption limitation applies to the cumulative consumption of all meters that qualify for virtual meter aggregation.
