On December 2, 2010, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation submitted a petition for approval of a long-term, 50 MW block of default supply for residential customers pursuant to the settlement of the Default Service Procurement Plan in docket number P-2008-2060309.

On February 17, 2011, the Commission entered a Tentative Order approving and modifying the petition. The Commission ordered that any comments to the Tentative Order be submitted within 10 days of its issuance.
