Dear Mr. Russell:

On July 19, 2011, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL) filed the results of its long term Solar Renewable Energy Credit (SREC) Solicitation (July 2011 Long Term SREC Solicitation). PPL's filing is submitted in accordance with the Company's Default Service Program, at Docket No. P-2008-2060309.

The July 2011 Long Term SREC Solicitation sought procurement of 24,000 SRECs to facilitate PPL's compliance with the Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards (AEPS) requirements for the eight year time period starting June 1, 2012 and ending May 31, 2020.


PPL requests that the Commission approve the bid results from the July 2011 Long Term SREC Solicitation on or before August 2, 2011.

Further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, since the bid results from the July 2011 Long Term SREC Solicitation appear to have been conducted in accordance with the procedures approved by the Commission. Therefore, we approve the bid results submitted for the July 2011 Long Term SREC Solicitation. However, any winning bid results, submitted for a facility not yet qualified to deliver alternative energy portfolio credits, are approved under the condition that qualified facility certification is received prior to the date the credits are to be delivered.

In addition, we direct PPL to disclose the results of the July 2011 Long Term SREC Solicitation in accordance with the Commission's Secretarial Letter in Re: Disclosure of Default Service Solicitation Results and Creation of a Default Service Rate Calculation Model, issued October 12, 2010 at Docket No. M-2009-2082042.
