The Public Utility Commission (PUC) will hold in-person public input hearings concerning PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's request for approval to build approximately 1.1 miles of new double-circuit 230 kilovolt (kV) transmission taps that are needed to connect the existing Susquehanna-Harwood #1 and #2 230 kV transmission lines to the new Tomhicken 230 kV Switchyard that are respectively located in Hazle Township, Luzerne County.

Registration to testify at a public input hearing is encouraged but not required. If you wish to testify, you are encouraged to pre-register with the Office of Administrative Law Judge by **4:00 p.m. on Friday, June 26, 2026.** Those who pre-register and provide the information listed below will be called to testify at the hearing in the order in which they preregister. If you want to attend a public input hearing (without testifying), you do not need to pre-register.

Need assistance with pre-registration? If you need assistance pre-registering to testify, you may have someone register for you, but they will need to provide all the information listed above. Additionally, if more than one person in your household would like to testify, one person

may pre-register for other individuals in the same household by providing the PUC Judges' Legal Assistant with the above-listed information for each individual.

Hearing exhibits: If you have any exhibits to which you will refer during the hearing, please email them to the Legal Assistant, at sumjayakum@pa.gov. The PUC Judges will forward your exhibits to all the parties.

Exhibits must be received by the Legal Assistant by **Tuesday, June 23, 2026**.

Requests for interpreters: If you require an interpreter, please pre-register as soon as possible. If you register too close to the hearing date, we may not have enough time to arrange for an interpreter. If you request an interpreter, the PUC will make reasonable efforts to have one present.
